Old Dominion Fast Draw

Hello Gun Fighters!

The "SWEET SHOOT", ODFD's 2013 Club Championship is November 9th and 10th!! This is two days of fantastic Cowboy Fast Draw!! This is how the match works!!! Each day is conducted as a separate match. Both are "Last Man Standing", best 3 out of 5, "3X", shotgun primed matches. If the weather cooperates and we are shooting outside in "Boothill Corral", it will all be shot at 21 feet. If the weather is bad and we have to shoot indoors in "Boothill Alley", we will shoot at 15 feet. Awards are given for each day's competition. Your performance in both days' matches determines overall award placements as well as determining the "2013 Sweet Shoot" Overall Event Champions as well as the 2013 ODFD Club Champions. Please note, you have to be a member of ODFD to be a Club Champion but DO NOT have to be an ODFD member to win the Overall Event Championships. The fee for the match is \$40.00, \$30 for spouse, \$20 for youth for BOTH DAYS or \$30.00, \$20 for spouse, \$10 for youth for one day. There are NO OTHER DISCOUNTS for this match. The match starts each day with registration beginning at 7:30am, and the safety meeting starts at 8:30, and the match begins both days at 9am!!! **PLEASE NOTE THE TIMES!!!!** We will be having a "Potluck Dinner" on Sunday immediately after the match before the awards ceremony. After the shooting on Saturday of the Sweet Shoot, there will be opportunities for you to participate and compete in a Bracket Match! Entry will be \$20!!! There will be 3 Brackets divided up as equally as possible by fastest times of the day. The winner of each Bracket gets half of that Brackets registration fees. The number of contestants will determine the cash payouts!!! The Bracket Matches are "2X", "2 out of 3", shotgun primed events all shot at 15 feet!!! Guaranteed to be some "Fast and Furious" shootin' and great competition in all of the brackets!! Come and visit us here in Virginia!! We will do our danged best to make ya feel welcome!!

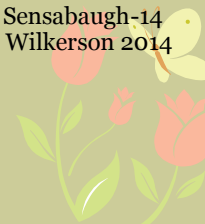
