

## Hunting Accuracy and Ethics By Rod Carter

If you're like me, this is the time of year our thoughts turn to the upcoming deer season, and we take our favorite deer hunting rifles to the range to ensure they are still sighted in from last season. It has been my observation that most hunters shoot from a bench rest until they feel their rifle is ready for a trophy whitetail, and then put them into a case and go home thinking they are ready for opening day. If their deer hunting rifle shoots within 1 inch at 100 yards, the rifle is above average. Most deer hunting rifles shoot 2 to 3 inch groups at 100 yards, which is acceptable for deer hunting under conditions where most shots are within 150 yards. More often than not, the bench rest is the only practice most hunters do before going to their stand on a cold November morning.

It's opening day and you have chosen a terrific stand and can see at least 300 yards. As you sit on the ground shivering, you see a trophy buck further away than you expected. You use your range finder and it ranges 275 yards. The buck is standing still at the moment giving you a great opportunity for a shot. You know your rifle can make the shot. The question is can *you* make this shot?


An "old" archery axiom is you should be able to hit a pie plate (9 inches) at 20 yards or whatever distance you feel comfortable in shooting. If your rifle shoots a 3 inch group at 100 yards, what does it shoot at 275 yards? Answer: A little over 8 inches. You may or may not hit the pie plate. If you don't know for sure, position a 9 inch target on Range C and find out. You will probably be surprised. Being able to hit a pie plate on the range from a bench rest is a much different than in the woods sitting on the ground. If you're not sure, try it.

It's much better to find out on the range than in the woods when your buck runs off limping or just runs off. You walk over to where the buck was standing only to find a small patch of hair and no blood. This could mean possibly a gut shot. NOT GOOD! You owe it to the animal you're hunting to know how your rifle shoots and how well you can shoot when not on the bench.

I wish you well this hunting season and above all be safe.

# The President's Corner

I'm writing this on the first day of Fall and I must say that I don't remember ever being so happy that summer was over. If they keep getting hotter every year I won't have to worry about old age getting me. Anyway, the point is that fall can make for some really pleasant days at the range so get out and get shooting. Our club has never been in better shape and pistol and rifle ranges are in great condition and the clays ranges are all up and running smoothly.

For any member who has considered shooting competitively or who might just want to join others who share a mutual interest in shooting, stop thinking about it and get out to a match. RRRC hosts an average of 65+ matches a year and they are all open to newcomers. New participants are the life blood of any sport and every venue at RRRC is eager to see more people with an interest in their sport.

Two that I want to mention are **High Power** and **Bench Rest**. **High Power** has more registered competitors than any other shooting sport in the U.S. yet we have a relatively small number of High Power competitors at RRRC. ### Utah Concealed Carry Firearm Permit Training

Virginia and 35 other states recognize the Utah Concealed Firearm Permit. That widespread recognition makes it good to have as an interstate traveler. Utah permit holders may legally carry while driving through many contiguous states. Those who plan on carrying out of state may find it very useful to have this as a second permit.

The 4-hour class required to apply for this permit will be offered at the RRRC clubhouse. Interested applicants should already hold a Virginia Concealed Carry Permit and have completed NRA First Steps Pistol or an equivalent pistol class. All necessary materials will be furnished. Club members and non-members are welcome. **Cost is \$55.00.**

### MATCH NEWS

#### SMALL BORE RIFLE SILHOUETTE MODIFIED – OCTOBER 3RD – Range A

Get your .22's out of the gunsafe and join us for the next Small Bore match. The course of fire for the silhouette match is a 40 round match consisting of 10 Chicken targets at 40 yards, 10 Pig targets at 60 yards, 10 turkey targets at 77 yards, and 10 ram targets at 100 yards. One shot at each target. Shooters have two and one half minutes to fire five shots, a one minute break, then two and a half minutes to fire 5 more shots.



Ammunition allowed is any .22 short, long, or long rifle, Standard or High Velocity. Hyper Velocity ammo such as Stingers or Vipers may not be used on the silhouettes. They are hard on the steel targets. If you want to use them on the paper targets, you may. 17 caliber rimfires are not allowed.


### Black Powder Cartridge Silhouette - Final Match of 2015!
